

The Spirit of the Game

Golf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game of golf.

Safety: Scorers should ensure that no one is standing in a position to be hit by the ball as the golfers hit their approach shots into the green.

No Disturbance or Distraction: Scorers should always show consideration for the players on the course and should not disturb their play by moving, talking or making any unnecessary noise. (*Ensure that any electronic device taken onto the course does not distract players*). Scorers should not stand on the green or

directly behind the ball, or directly behind the hole, when a player is about to putt.
